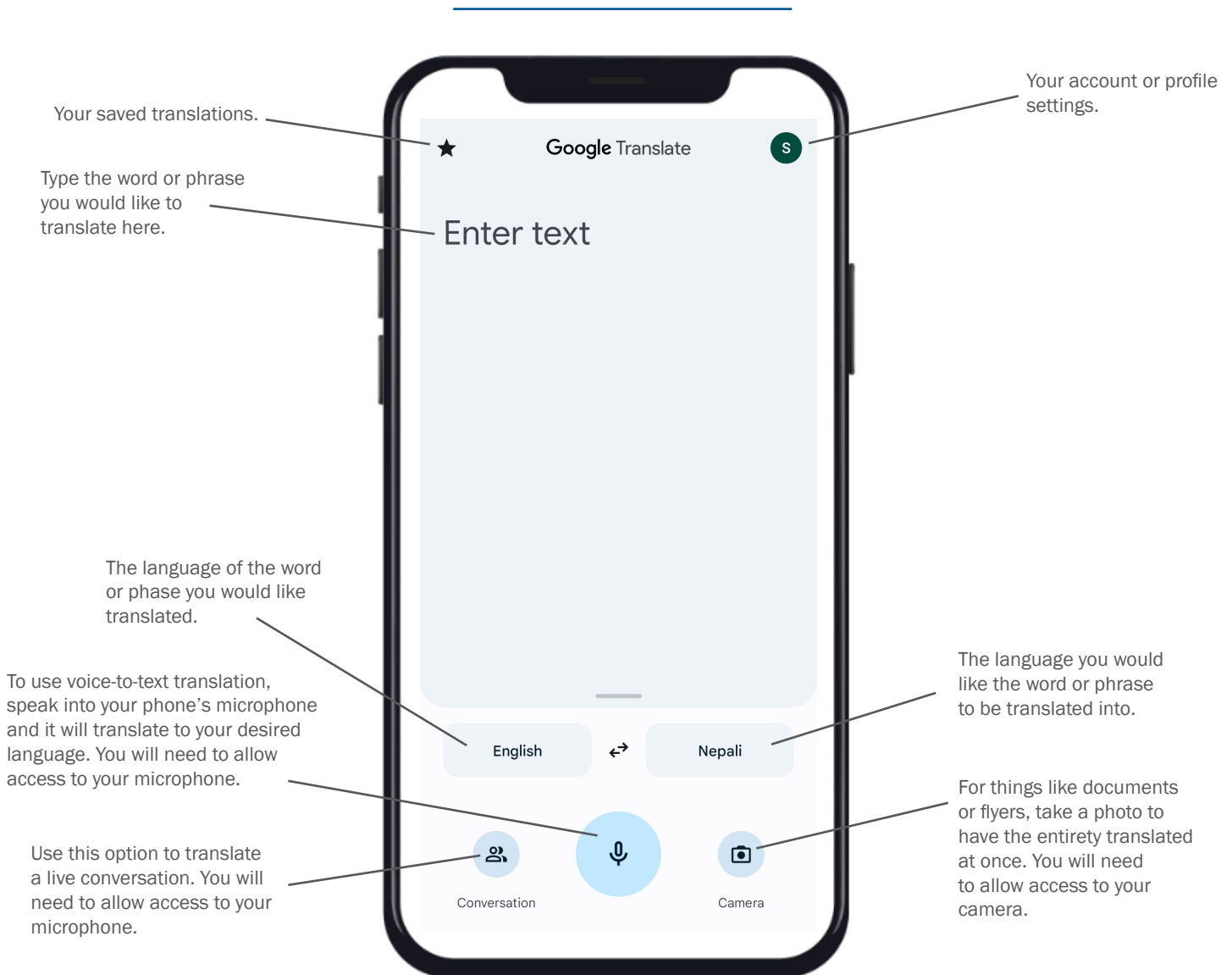


How to use Google Translate



Getting set up

1. Open your phone's purchasing store (Apple App Store, Google Playstore, etc.) and search for **"Google Translate."**
2. Download the app.
3. Open the app. You can log into your Google account, but this is not necessary to use the app features.
4. Select your language. Some languages can be downloaded for use online.





Helpful tips

1. Tap the **Pen Icon** on the screen to write out a word to be translated.
2. After typing or writing out a word to be translated, hit **“Enter.”** From this screen, you have additional options as follows.
3. Tap the **Clock Icon** at the top to see your recent translation history.
4. Tap the **Star Icon** to save the translation if you think it’s something you will refer to often.
5. Tap the **three dots in the top right corner** to send feedback about the translation.
6. Tap the **Speaker Icon** to have the translation read out loud.
7. Tap the **Copy Icon** to copy the text to your clipboard.
8. Tap the **Thumbs Up/Thumbs Down Icon** to rate the translation.
9. Scroll down to see examples of the translation used in a sentence, conjugations of verbs and other similar words.
10. You can return the original screen at anytime by tapping **“Home”** in the top left corner, or by tapping **“New Translation.”**
11. If you don’t want to download the app, you can search **“Google Translate”** in your phone’s default browser and still use many of the basic functions of the translation service.
